 - v. LJ Parkway, Phase 8B – sidewalk, landscape, and irrigation; and
 - vi. University Boulevard and LJ Parkway Commercial Frontage Trails; and
 - c. approval of pay estimates, change orders, and final acceptance, including:
 - i. Avalon, Section 12A – sidewalk, landscape, and irrigation;
 - ii. Avalon, Section 16B – sidewalk, landscape, and irrigation;
 - iii. Avalon, Section 20 and 24B – sidewalk, landscape, and irrigation;
 - iv. LJ Parkway, Phase 5 pedestrian tunnel and landscaping;
 - v. North Wetland Park.
